Job Summary

This is a very busy hand and wrist surgery firm. (Only alternate Wed pm free)
You will be exposed to common and other not so common hand and wrist pathology in the clinic and theatre. There is a weekly new hand trauma clinic where both bony and soft tissue injuries are seen and dealt with either there and then or later on the trauma list in the afternoon. You will be exposed to a variety of hand and wrist trauma be it bony or soft tissue.
This post can be made to suit any level of registrar experience/training, but the full benefit will be achieved only with a senior trainee.
You will be able to complete the minimum number of carpal tunnel releases for your whole StR training in this attachment.
There is commitment for the trainee to general trauma 1 in 9 weeks. This is achieved by joining Mr Page for his trauma week. During this week there is no hand surgery commitment.
I am one of only two local trainers who has attained the diploma in hand surgery. I conduct a series of tutorial covering most of the hand and wrist surgery syllabus on a weekly basis during each attachment.
Participation in the monthly journal club and bimonthly audit meeting is encouraged.
