### Job Summary

Mr Duffy and Mr Longstaff have previously both been nominated for trainer of the year.

This placement is suitable for pre and post fellowship trainees. Appropriate training will be given in both primary hip and knee arthroplasty plus knee arthroscopy and will be tailored to seniority and interest of the trainee. On average 60-70 primaries and 10-15 revisions are performed per 6 months. There will be also be significant exposure to hip and knee revision surgery, with level of involvement depending on trainee experience and interest.

We work alongside Mr Shaw, Mr Scott and the Microbiologists within the Arthroplasty MDT managing infected arthroplasty and periprosthetic fractures across the trust with monthly meetings.

There is 1 in 9 participation in the trauma week on call. The unit admits approximately 1500 trauma admissions per year.

The unit as a whole has a strong training pedigree and trainees are encouraged to take advantage of other Consultants lists and clinics when their trainer is absent.

We hold twice weekly x-ray meetings plus a monthly journal club. Research is actively encouraged and the unit regularly presents at regional and national meetings. We are more than happy to discuss the posts further in person Mr Longstaff 0191 333 6996 and Mr Duffv 0191 333 2607.
