Job Summary

These 2 posts offer the opportunity for training in general trauma, paediatric trauma, complex upper limb trauma and both open and arthroscopic shoulder surgery.

The trainees are able to choose the aspect of the job that they are most interested in and tailor the timetables towards either the trauma or elective aspects, which suit their training needs.

Mr Williams, Mr Henman and Mr Aldridge are all active members of AO Faculty. All levels of trainee will find good training opportunity delivered with consultant supervision.

These posts offer access to cadaveric simulation training courses at the Newcastle Surgical Training Centre (nstcsurg.org)

There is an active consultant led trauma education programme. Daily business trauma meetings are supplemented by a weekly educational MDT trauma meeting, with monthly journal club and a monthly hospital major trauma MDT review.

In addition to concentrated clinical trauma exposure, trauma research opportunities are available to those interested trainees. There is an active consultant led trauma education programme.
