Job Summary

This post offers training from two consultants with interests in orthopaedic oncology and foot and ankle surgery. The opportunities in this post can be tailored to the needs of the trainee, but include:

- Exposure to all aspects of orthopaedic oncology practice including multidisciplinary team working, the management of a wide range of benign and malignant bone and soft tissue tumours, and communication skills. Some primary joint replacements.
- The opportunity to participate in research and audit in both specialties.
- Trauma in the Newcastle Major Trauma Centre
- Exposure to all aspects of Foot and Ankle surgery including fortnightly Multidisciplinary academic meetings in which complex cases are examined and discussed. The trainee will have exposure to a wide range of surgeries including forefoot correction and osteotomies, arthrodeses, ankle and subtalar arthroscopy and joint replacements.

Mr Gerrand is a former Trainer of the Year, and is an active clinical researcher. He is a past president of BOOS, and is a member of the NCIN, NCRI and specialised Commissioning Clinical Reference Groups.

Mr Torres is current chairman of the Northern Orthopaedic Foot and Ankle Society (NOFAS) and actively involved in clinical research.
