Job Summary

An opportunity for immersion in complex and revision hip and knee arthroplasty with two of the most experienced arthroplasty surgeons in the region. The two surgeons perform 70 revision surgeries per annum. Ideally suited to a senior trainee who wishes to develop a revision arthroplasty interest.

The trainee will attend outpatient clinics with both surgeons and an all day arthroplasty list with each. The post also includes on call commitments at the Major Trauma Centre, RVI and specialist peri-prosthetic fracture service. There are regular arthroplasty meetings and the Unit has a multi-disciplinary musculo-skeletal infection team.

We have 10 years PROMS registry data of arthroplasty patients enabling audit and research projects, together with participation in ongoing Clinical Trials (Exeter), audit (BHR, MRK knee) and Northern Retrieval Registry for all implants from revision. Publication and presentation at minimum national level meeting is expected, supported by Professorial Academic and research department.

The post offers unparalleled access to world-class cadaveric education at the Primary & Revision THR TKR courses in Newcastle Surgical Training Centre (**nstcsurg.org**) and to perform cadaveric research.
