This post offers training in a high volume foot and ankle team with additional exposure to arthroplasty. The post may be suited to any level of trainee as it has exposure to both simple and complex foot/ankle and arthroscopic surgery. The trainee should gain exposure to all aspects of foot and ankle pathology, including forefoot problems, sports injuries and degenerative disease sufficient to gain valuable experience to develop it further. There is abundant clinical database for research and publications.

Orthopaedic trauma is managed according to a trauma week system with protected trauma lists for the trainee to develop his or her trauma management skills. Complex Foot and Ankle trauma referred to Mr Limaye.

There are various educational meetings within the department. These include a daily trauma meeting, weekly registrar teaching and journal clubs. The trainee will be expected to contribute to the department's audit & governance meetings and will have the opportunity to become involved with departmental research.
