Job Summary

This post will provide the trainee with a good grounding in Hand & Wrist Surgery. Both trainers will provide ample clinical & operating opportunities with a strong emphasis on teaching. Our teaching and training extends beyond the Trust and is reflected in our passion for it. It is expected that trainees will have gained sufficient knowledge & clinical experience to pass the Hand & Wrist section in the FRCS exam (Ideal for anyone nearing the Clinical Exam) and attain the indicative numbers expected for CCT. The spectrum of work includes basic and complex Hand and Wrist Surgery including complex hand trauma. In addition the trainee will spend one week out of every six doing protected trauma with a trainer who is fellowship trained in trauma. Both trainers provide opportunities for research and audit, and are involved in local and regional research committees and have been Principle Investigators on portfolio registered multicentre trials. There is also a departmental expectation that audits will be presented at Clinical Governance meetings. There are weekly consultant led teaching sessions on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
