### Job Summary

The post is based at Wansbeck hospital, but will involve working in all Northumbria hospitals.

This is a high volume post offering exposure to all aspects of knee surgery (excluding revision arthroplasty). The post is suitable for junior trainees looking to develop basic arthroscopy and arthroplasty skill, but also is of value to more senior trainees looking to develop an interest in soft tissue knee problems. The trainee will also be able to gain further experience in hip arthroplasty.

They should gain sufficient exposure to undertake arthroplasty to level 3, should be able to undertake ACL reconstruction with the assistance of the trainer, will gain experience in the management of the multi-ligament injured knee and the different methods of management of the knee with single compartment degenerative disease.

Orthopaedic trauma is managed according to a trauma week system and the trainee will have the opportunity to develop his or her trauma management skills over five or six trauma weeks.

The post also offers trainees the opportunity to become exposed to management activities and will have the opportunity to contribute to quality improvement projects.

All trainees are expected to contribute to departmental teaching and training,
