Job Summary

This post offers training from a single trainer with a special interest in all aspects of knee surgery. The post is suitable for both senior and junior trainees and can be tailored to the needs of the individual. There are opportunities to learn basic arthroscopy and arthroplasty for early years trainees and complex ligament surgery and revision arthroplasty for post exam trainees. The trainee will be exposed to large numbers of arthroscopic and arthroplasty cases as shown by the log books of previous trainees.

Orthopaedic trauma is managed according to a trauma week system and the trainee will have the opportunity to develop his or her trauma management skills over five or six trauma weeks. There will be opportunities to follow complex trauma cases when they are referred on to in house trauma or upper limb specialists.

Mr Emmerson has been nominated for Trainer of the Year twice.

There are daily trauma meetings, a weekly seminar and a monthly journal club.

The trainee will have the opportunity to contribute to the audit & governance meetings and the orthopaedic department at Northumbria has an outstanding reputation for research.
