### Job Summary

Comprehensive experience in hip and knee joint replacement and revision surgery. Opportunity to progress to independent, supervised primary hip arthroplasty, through a posterior approach, using the Exeter Hip system and primary knee using the Nexgen knee.

For senior trainees progressive involvement in revision hip, and to a numerically lesser extent revision knee surgery. Capable, trainees will be performing revision hip surgery, under supervision.

The trainee will form part of the 'Arthroplasty Team' comprising Mssrs Partington, Carluke, Reed, 2 SPRS and a senior BOA clinical leadership fellow, and a junior fellow. This team will cross cover inpatient care and clinical activity to maximize training.

The unit performs over 2300 primary joint replacements per year and a large number of revisions. Recent NJR figures show this team performed around 681 joints replacements per year including 84 revisions. These are excellent posts for the delivery of JCST indicative numbers.

Weekly multidisciplinary Revision Meeting with the team, and Infectious Disease, Microbiology and Infection Surveillance Teams.

Clinical commitments at Wansbeck, North Tyneside and Hexham Hospitals. On call is currently 1 in 20 including night shifts, at the Northumbria Specialist Emergency Care Hospital. Additional training opportunities when other trainees are away within the team. Cover for other teams may be required.
