Job Summary

This post offers training from two Lower Limb Arthroplasty Surgeon with special interest in complex trauma including Pelvis and Acetabular fracture management. Mr Nanu is a previous Trainer of the Year and teaches regularly on AO trauma courses National and International. Mr Krishnan is also an AO Faculty and organises the monthly Sunderland Fracture Forum for the regional trainees.

One of the key attractions of this post is the opportunity to learn and perform THR through lateral (AMN) and posterior (MK) approach. The trainees would be exposed to both cementless and cemented THR. In addition adequate exposure to TKR and revision THR/TKR will be available. This post is therefore more suited for senior trainees.

The unit is a large and busy District General Hospital, with trauma being managed by two Consultants on a trauma week system, allowing the trainee the opportunity to develop an interest and skills in the management of all types of trauma including complex trauma such as spines, pelvic / acetabular fixation reconstruction, and limb reconstruction using ring fixation.

There are daily trauma meetings and weekly educational meetings, with monthly journal clubs organised by (MK). The trainee will be expected to become involved in unit audit and governance meetings, and would be welcome to develop any research interests.
