Job Summary

This post offers training from two trainers with a special interest in all aspects of hand and wrist surgery. The post offers experience in elective hand and wrist surgery, general orthopaedic trauma and hand trauma (including flexor tendon surgery). Hand Trauma is seen in dedicated multidisciplinary Hand Trauma Clinics, serviced by dedicated Hand Trauma Lists. The weekly clinical timetable can be flexible to accommodate the training requirements of the trainee. The trainee will have the opportunity to gain general trauma experience on a trauma week basis.

Trainees of all grades will be able to gain sufficient exposure in hand and wrist surgical procedures as our practice covers all aspects of this sub-specialty. Senior trainees will gain experience with complex hand trauma cases and arthroscopic and reconstructive wrist surgery with more junior trainees learning tendon repair techniques and treating the common conditions of the hand.

There is a monthly journal club and departmental upper limb teaching. The trainee will be expected to contribute to the department's monthly audit & governance meetings. In addition trainees will be given ample opportunity to undertake research under the guidance of both trainers, who are actively involved in several on going research projects.
