Job Summary

This post offers training from two Lower Limb Arthroplasty Surgeons with an additional exposure to complex lower limb trauma including Pelvis and Acetabular fracture management.

Mr Green is an experienced trainer who runs a busy lower limb arthroplasty and revision practice. He is active as an educator, participating as faculty and organising local and regional courses.

One day a week is in theatre with Mr Krishnan with involvement in arthroplasty and complex trauma cases. Mr Krishnan is also an AO Faculty member and organises the monthly Sunderland Fracture Forum for the region's trainees.

This post offers something to trainees at all levels, from an introduction to or consolidating experience of joint replacement surgery, to the development of more specialist skills in revision surgery and complex trauma.

The unit is a large and busy District General Hospital, with trauma being managed by two Consultants on a trauma week system, allowing the trainee the opportunity to develop an interest and skills in the management of all types of trauma including complex trauma such as spines, pelvic / acetabular fixation reconstruction, and limb reconstruction using ring fixation.

There are daily trauma meetings and weekly educational meetings, with monthly journal clubs organised by (MK). The trainee will be expected to become involved in unit audit and governance meetings, and would be welcome to develop any research interests.
